This paper contains some advance notions of western logic like quantification logic, which helps students to become aware the developments into the field of logic. The CBCS Philosophy syllabus of the second semester also provides one minor papers/GE papers for the students of Programme course. This paper is concerned with ethics. The Study of ethics makes students aware about the meaning and purpose ethical principles which ultimately helps students to live a sound life.

SEMESTER-III
